A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE TO ADD SECTION 125.1130 AND ADOPTING COUNCIL POLICY 200-10 TO PROVIDE FOR THE HONORARY NAMING OF PUBLIC STREETS IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15301.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) has before it an ordinance to amend Chapter 12, Article 5, Division 11 of the San Diego Municipal Code by adding section 125.1130, which will allow the City Council to name sections of public streets in honor of certain individuals and organizations and a resolution to adopt Council Policy 200-10, which will establish the criteria and procedures for selecting those to be recognized with such honorary street names and also establish the standards for the accompanying signage ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (California Public Resources Code sections 21000-21177), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, section 15000, *et seq.*) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) has considered the potential environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, on DEC 1 3 2016, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment because it involves a minor alteration to existing public streets with negligible or no expansion of use; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego determines that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301 (Existing Facilities).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council has determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
