AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 12, ARTICLE 5, DIVISION 11 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING NEW SECTION 125.1130 RELATING TO HONORARY STREET NAMES.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego desires to recognize individuals and organizations that are of particular importance to the City of San Diego or have made significant contributions to improving the quality of life in the City by naming sections of public streets in their honor; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance will amend the San Diego Municipal Code to authorize the Council to confer honorary names to public streets and allow for the installation of appropriate signage, which shall be distinct from and not change or replace existing street names and signs; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 12, Article 5, Division 11 of the San Diego Municipal Code is amended by adding new section 125.1130, to read as follows:

§125.1130 Honorary Street Names

(a) The City Council may name sections of *streets* not exceeding one block in length in honor and recognition of individuals or organizations that are of particular importance to the City of San Diego or have made significant contributions to improving the quality of life in the City. The honorary naming of *streets* under this section is separate and distinct from the process for naming or renaming *streets* provided by this Division and shall not replace, supersede, or otherwise affect existing names of *streets*.

The criteria and procedure for selecting those individuals and (b) organizations for recognition with honorary street names and the design standards for the accompanying signs shall be provided by Council Policy.

Notwithstanding the provisions of Chapter 14, Article 2, Division 12, (c) signs for honorary street names may be placed in streets. Signs for honorary street names shall be clearly distinguishable from official street name signs by color, use of the word "honorary" in the legend, or by other

design aspects.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
