

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 20830 (NEW SERIES)

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUN 07 2017

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH NORTHROP GRUMMAN TO EXTEND THE AGREEMENT PAST FIVE YEARS AND TO EXPEND AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$63,691.

WHEREAS, Northrop Grumman Systems Corporation (Contractor) provides software maintenance for products used in the San Diego Police Department's (Police Department) complex electronic Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system; and

WHEREAS, the CAD system allows police dispatchers and field police officers to share vital communications regarding incident dispatch, calls for service, location awareness, and critical operational information; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department is in the midst of upgrading and replacing the current CAD system (CAD Replacement Project), at which time some of the software components will also be upgraded and replaced; and

WHEREAS, it is critical to continue receiving software support and maintenance from the Contractor for the Police Department's ongoing operations until the CAD Replacement Project is completed and the new CAD system is implemented; and

WHEREAS, a Master Maintenance Agreement (Agreement) with Contractor was executed for a term of 5 one-year terms, commencing on July 2, 2012, and ending on July 1, 2017, totaling \$435,485; and

WHEREAS, the CAD Replacement Project is now estimated to be completed by December 30, 2017, one year later than originally expected; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department requires Contractor's services until December 30, 2017, six (6) months beyond the original term; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department and Contractor want to amend the Agreement to extend the term for an additional six (6) months through December 31, 2017, at a cost of approximately \$63,691; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the Agreement as amended is \$499,176; and

WHEREAS, the additional six (6) months extends the original Agreement beyond five years; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with San Diego Charter section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by ordinance adopted by a two-thirds' majority vote of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to San Diego Municipal Code section 22.3016, on February 24, 2017, a certificate of sole source procurement was approved by the Director of Purchasing and Contracting because the services required are only available from Contractor; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a first amendment to the Agreement with Northrop Grumman Systems Corporation, under the terms and conditions set forth in the document on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. 00- 20830


Section 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$63,691 from Fund 100000, General Fund, for the purpose of executing this first amendment to the Agreement with Northrop Grumman Systems Corporation, contingent upon

the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates demonstrating that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, available.

Section 3. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.




