AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH SAN DIEGO ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS (SANDAG) FOR ON-CALL TRANSPORTATION MODELING SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the Planning Department is responsible for the long-range planning of San Diego's communities and neighborhoods; the Planning Department also maintains a comprehensive, citywide General Plan, and updates and amends the City's community plans, and facilities implementation of those plans; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department work plan includes community plan updates and amendments, transit-oriented development plans, and active transportation plans, planning initiatives, and special study area projects; and

WHEREAS, in order to facilitate the Planning Department's work plan, an integral part of transportation analysis is transportation modeling; and

WHEREAS, transportation modeling involves a thorough and complex computer process, including population synthesis, long-term choice models, mobility choice models and daily activity pattern models, to ultimately provide calibrated-existing and future year forecasted daily traffic and transit volumes, based on future land use assumptions among other factors; and

WHEREAS, in keeping with the paradigm shift in mobility planning, activity based modeling, now available from SANDAG includes forecasted pedestrian and bicycle trips as well as forecasted vehicle and transit trips; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department uses the existing and forecasted data to assist in creating the City's General Plan, community plans, and mobility and land use policies; and

WHEREAS, Transportation modeling data is used to guide decisions in order to provide for a multimodal transportation network that is equitable for all users; and

WHEREAS, under San Diego Charter section 99, a supermajority vote of the City Council is required for passage of this ordinance; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, or his designee is authorized to execute an amendment to the agreement with SANDAG for an as-needed On-Call Transportation Modeling Services for an amount not to exceed \$500,000 for a period of five years, in addition to the original contract term, with a total term not to exceed 10 years, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 20844 .

Section 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$500,000 from various funds upon identification of projects, for the purpose of funding the above agreement; contingent upon the adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal years and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditures are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

Section 3. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
