AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION
OF AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO
AND THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY REGIONAL AIRPORT
AUTHORITY RELATED TO EMERGENCY MEDICAL
TECHNICIAN-PARAMEDIC SERVICES AT SAN DIEGO
INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

WHEREAS, San Diego Charter section 99 provides, in pertinent part: “No contract, agreement or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by ordinance adopted by a two-thirds’ majority vote of the members elected to the Council”; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) is responsible for providing emergency medical technician-paramedic services in a specified geographic area, known as an “exclusive operating area,” in accordance with an agreement between the City and the County of San Diego, Department of Health Services, dated June 18, 1997, and California Health and Safety Code section 1797.224; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego International Airport, located on North Harbor Drive, is in the City’s exclusive operating area; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego International Airport is operated by the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority (Airport Authority), a local governmental entity of regional government; and

WHEREAS, the Airport Authority and the City intend to enter into an agreement, allowing for the City to provide emergency medical technician-paramedic services, including a stand-by ambulance, at the San Diego International Airport and the Airport Authority to reimburse the City for the direct and indirect costs of the services; and

WHEREAS, the Airport Authority will pay the City approximately \$767,000 per fiscal year for the emergency medical technician-paramedic services, and the City will subcontract the services to its emergency medical services provider, which is currently American Medical Response (AMR); however, AMR is not a party to the contract between the Airport Authority and the City; and

WHEREAS, the City is providing the Airport Authority cost-recoverable services for an amount not to exceed \$4.5 million over five years; and

WHEREAS, the proposed agreement is for a five-year term, with the option to renew for two additional one-year extensions, which may be exercised at the sole discretion of the Airport Authority, thus requiring City Council approval of the agreement in accordance with San Diego Charter section 99; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the City Council approves Contract 210269-OS, which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. 00-20845, between the Airport Authority and the City, authorizing the City to be reimbursed by the Airport Authority for emergency medical technician-paramedic services provided by the City at the San Diego International Airport; approval is retroactive to a contract commencement date of July 1, 2017 and continuing until June 30, 2022, with an option for two additional one-year extensions, which may be exercised at the sole discretion of the Airport Authority.


Section 2. That the City Council authorizes the Mayor or his designee to execute, for and on behalf of the City, Contract 210269-OS, including any extensions of the contract, as set forth in this ordinance.

Section 3. That the City Council authorizes the City's Chief Financial Officer to expend funds to pay the City's Emergency Medical Services provider for the subcontracted services associated with Contract 210269-OS, contingent upon adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year and upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing a certificate certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

Section 4. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.


