AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING AMENDMENT NO. 4 TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND OVERLAND, PACIFIC & CUTLER, INC., FOR CONSULTING SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego is a named defendant in the case arising from the closure of a mobile home park on Mission Bay: *De Anza Cove Homeowners Association, et al. v. City of San Diego*, San Diego Superior Court Case No. GIC 821191; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council authorized the resolution of this litigation as to the certified class of residents of the mobile home park, said resolution is to abide by the Amended Judgment dated October 16, 2014, entered in this lawsuit with payment of attorneys' fees calculated at one third of the award plus costs as awarded by the Court, for an amount consistent with the amounts set forth in San Diego Resolution R-309422 (Dec. 17, 2014), on file herein; and

WHEREAS, Overland, Pacific & Cutler, Inc. will continue the scope of work to include payment of claims to the residents based on the Amended Judgment dated October 16, 2014, as described in Amendment No. 4 to the Agreement Between the City of San Diego and Overland, Pacific & Cutler, Inc., for Consulting Services, which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as 00-20852; and,

WHEREAS, under San Diego Charter section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by ordinance adopted by a two-thirds' majority vote of the City Council; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute Amendment No. 4 to the contract with Overland, Pacific & Cutler, Inc., extending the contract through December 2017, in connection with the closure of De Anza Cove Mobile Home Park, including compliance with the October 16, 2014 Amended Judgment in *De Anza Cove Homeowners Association, Inc., et al. v. City of San Diego, et al.*, San Diego Superior Court Case No. GIC 821191. Funding is from the Public Liability Fund No. 720045, approved via San Diego Resolution R-309422 (Dec. 17, 2014) on December 16, 2014.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
