A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM FOR PHASE II DESIGN OF THE CHOLLAS CREEK MULTI-USE PATH.

WHEREAS, on June 29, 2016, the State of California Transportation Commission awarded Active Transportation Program grant funding to the City of San Diego to fund Phase II project design of a 0.75 mile multi-use pedestrian and bicycle path, linking Dorothy Petway Neighborhood Park in the Southeastern San Diego community through the Barrio Logan community to East Harbor Drive (Project); and

WHEREAS, the pedestrian and bicycle path is proposed to be an extension of the Chollas Creek to Bayshore Bikeway Multi-Use Path along Chollas Creek developed within public rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the pedestrian and bicycle path would be primarily developed as Class I and Class II bicycle facilities, with the possibility of a Class III facility along a short stretch of Rigel Street; and

WHEREAS, a resolution authorizing execution of the grant agreement is required in order to obtain the \$695,000 in grant funding; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to apply, accept, and take all necessary actions to secure up to \$695,000 in Active Transportation Program grant funds awarded by the State of California Transportation Commission for the Project.

2. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to enter into a grant agreement to

accept the Active Transportation Program grant funds for the Project.

3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend

an amount not to exceed \$695,000 of Active Transportation Program grant funds contingent

upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement, if the grant funding is secured, and contingent

upon the Chief Financial Officer certifying that funds are available.

4. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase the Capital

Improvements Program Budget in the CIP Annual Allocation, A-IA.00001, Minor Bike

Facilities, by an amount not to exceed \$695,000, for the Project.

5. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-

bearing account, if required.
