A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING A CONSULTANT CONTRACT AND RELATED EXPENDITURES FOR CONSTRUCTION DESIGN SERVICES FOR THE EAST VILLAGE GREEN PHASE 1 PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the East Village Green Project (EVG Project) consists of two blocks bounded by 13th, 15th, F, and G streets located downtown in the East Village neighborhood and includes the development of 80,000 square feet of park improvements, a community center, and parking garage (Phase 1); and

WHEREAS, Civic San Diego administers the EVG Project on behalf of the City pursuant to that certain Agreement for Consulting Services by and between the City and Civic San Diego for Successor Agency and Housing Successor Agency Services, and Downtown Community Parking District projects, dated December 16, 2016 (Operating Agreement); and

WHEREAS, Civic San Diego wishes to enter the Professional Services Agreement with the Office of James Burnett, attached to Staff Report No. CSD-16-19 as Attachment D (Agreement), for design management services for the EVG Project; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code section 22.3207(b) authorizes the award of a consultant contract for a public works project without City Council approval if (1) the public works project was previously identified and appropriated in, and will be funded through, the Annual Capital Improvement Program budget, (2) the contract does not exceed \$1,000,000, and (3) the total cumulative amount of contract awards to the consultant, including the current award, does not exceed \$1,000,000 in any fiscal year. However, Civic San Diego Board Policy 4.0 –

Purchasing & Contracting, requires City Council authorization for professional services contracts

of \$250,000 or more to be executed by Civic San Diego for the benefit of the City; and

WHEREAS, the preparation of construction documents for Phase 1 of the EVG Project is

for an amount not to exceed \$4,756,405, with the design of street and park improvements to be

expended from the Development Impact Fee (DIF) Fund in an amount not to exceed \$4,389,270,

and the design of the parking garage to be expended from the Downtown Community Parking

District Fund in an amount not to exceed \$367,135; and

WHEREAS, on June 22, 2016, pursuant to Resolution No. R-310528, the Council

approved the expenditure for the design of the parking garage; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Civic San Diego is authorized to enter into the Agreement. 1.

2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed

\$4,389,270 from CIP S-16012, East Village Green Phase 1, Fund 400122 – Centre City DIF,

solely and exclusively for the Agreement, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing

a certificate certifying that all funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the

City Treasurer.
