A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING APPLICATION AND AWARD FOR GRANT FUNDING UNDER THE TRANSNET ENVIRONMENTAL MITIGATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, in February 2016, the San Diego Association of Government (SANDAG)

Board of Directors approved a competitive grant process to solicit land management proposals
and allocated \$1.8 million of TransNet Environmental Mitigation Program funds for Land

Management Grant Program projects that promote: (1) Threat Reduction Stewardship, and
(2) Species and Habitat Recovery; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego Public Utilities Department manages approximately 41,000 acres of undeveloped land around its reservoirs and this grant funding will address the habitat protection of endangered and threatened species through revegetation, decommissioning of trails, and fencing of key access points; and

WHEREAS, this project proposal requests \$50,000 from Water Utility Operating Fund (700011) with a City in-kind services match of \$5,000 if the grant funding is secured in the SANDAG Land Management Program grant funding to address a high-priority species, the Coastal Cactus Wren, in the Bernardo Bay area east of Hodges Reservoir (Project); NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to make application for a SANDAG Environmental Mitigation Program (EMP) Grant and to take all necessary actions to secure grant funding for an amount not to exceed \$50,000 in SANDAG Grant funds for Project purposes.

- 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$50,000 from the Water Utility Operating Fund (700011) for the Project if the grant funding is secured.
- 3. That the City Council certifies that the required matching funds of \$5,000 are available for City staff in-kind services and authorizes the Chief Financial Officer, upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement, to transfer the matching funds of \$5,000 from Water Utility Operating Fund (700011) for purposes of the Project.
- 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to take all necessary actions to administer, monitor, and manage such grant funds when received.
