A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT INSTALLATION OF ANGLE PARKING ON WABASKA DRIVE BETWEEN WABASKA COURT AND VOLTAIRE STREET IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15301.

WHEREAS, in conjunction with plans to restripe Wabaska Drive from Nimitz Boulevard to Voltaire Street and create bikeways, the City of San Diego plans to create angled parking on the east side of that section of Wabaska Drive (Project); and

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code section 21084 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, section 15000 *et seq.*) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) has considered the potential environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, on FEB 1 4 2017, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment because it involves a minor alteration to an existing public street with negligible or no expansion of use; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council determines that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301 (Existing Facilities).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council has determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
