A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DENYING THREE APPEALS AND UPHOLDING THE ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION FOR A CONTRACT WITH THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, ANIMAL AND PLANT HEALTH INSPECTION SERVICE WILDLIFE SERVICES FOR PREDATOR MANAGEMENT AT THE MISSION BAY LEAST TERN SITES AND NORTHERN WILDLIFE PRESERVE.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego desires to execute a contract with the United States

Department of Agriculture, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service Wildlife Services

(USDA) for predator management services at the Mission Bay least tern sites and Northern

Wildlife Preserve (Project); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Project is to protect endangered California least terns and endangered light-footed Ridgway's rails and their nests from predation at nesting sites in Mission Bay and at the Northern Wildlife Preserve; and

WHEREAS, on December 23, 2016, the City of San Diego's Planning Department determined the Project to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.) pursuant to CEQA Guideline sections 15307 (Actions by Regulatory Agencies for Protection of Natural Resources) and 15308 (Actions by Regulatory Agencies for Protection of the Environment); and

WHEREAS, on January 6, 2017, Dr. Gary Weitzman on behalf of the San Diego Humane Society filed an Environmental Determination Appeal Application for the Project; on January 10, 2017, San Diego Animal Advocates filed an Environmental Determination Appeal Application for the Project; and, on January 11, 2017, San Diego Sierra Club filed an Environmental

(R-2017-413)

Determination Appeal Application for the Project (collectively, the Appeals). The Appeals each

stated that CEQA Guidelines sections 15307 and 15308 do not apply to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Appeals were heard by the Council of the City of San Diego (City

Council) on March 7, 2017; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 280(a)(2), this resolution is not subject to veto by the

Mayor because this matter requires the City Council to act as a quasi-judicial body and where a

public hearing was required by law implicating due process rights of individuals affected by the

decision and where the Council was required by law to consider evidence at the hearing and to

make legal findings based on the evidence presented; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the three appeals

to the determination that the Project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guideline sections

15307 (Actions by Regulatory Agencies for Protection of Natural Resources) and 15308

(Actions by Regulatory Agencies for Protection of the Environment) are hereby denied and that

based upon the evidence in the record, the environmental determination is upheld.
