A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE SETTING ASIDE OF THAT CERTAIN PORTION OF DEDICATED CITY PARKLAND, COMMONLY KNOWN AS LA JOLLA OPEN SPACE, LOCATED IN THE LA JOLLA COMMUNITY, FOR THE OPENING AND MAINTENANCE OF A CITY STREET, PURSUANT TO SAN DIEGO CHARTER SECTION 55, IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15303(d).

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) desires to set aside that certain portion of dedicated City parkland, commonly known as La Jolla Open Space, located in the La Jolla Community for the opening and maintenance of a City street pursuant to San Diego Charter Section 55 (Project); and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), states that CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300 – 15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has determined that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15303(d), New

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Construction or Conversion of Small Structures, and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the potential environmental effect of the Project; and

WHEREAS, on APR Q 4 2017, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment because the type of new construction or conversion of small structures contemplated as part of the Project is not an area of statewide, regional or area wide concern identified in CEQA Guidelines section 15206(b)(4); NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego determines that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15303(d), and that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
