A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 BUDGET REPORTS FOR SPECIFIED PARKING AND BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT AREAS.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Parking and Business Improvement Area Law of 1989 and/or its predecessor law (California Streets and Highways Code sections 36500-36551) ("1989 Act"), the following seventeen parking and business improvement areas were established by and in the City of San Diego to annually levy and collect assessments on businesses located within the specified areas to finance certain improvements and activities within such areas (each, a "1989 Act District" and collectively, "1989 Act Districts"):

- 1. Adams Avenue Business Improvement District (Ordinances 16479; 18087; 19749);
- 2. City Heights Business Improvement District (Ordinance 16918);
- 3. College Area Business Improvement District (Ordinances 18263; 18539);
- 4. Diamond Business Improvement District (Ordinances 18262; 18540);
- 5. East Village Business Improvement District (Ordinance 19881);
- 6. El Cajon Business Improvement District (Ordinance 16480);
- 7. El Cajon Boulevard Business Improvement District (Ordinance 16919);
- 8. Gaslamp Quarter Business Improvement District (Ordinances 15647; 17664)
- 9. Hillcrest Business Improvement District (Ordinances 16230; 17340);
- 10. La Jolla Business Improvement District (Ordinances 17458; 17803);
- 11. Little Italy Business Improvement District (Ordinances 18374; 18541);
- 12. Mission Hills Business Improvement District (Ordinance 17229);
- 13. North Park Business Improvement District (Ordinances 16481; 19780);

- 14. Ocean Beach Business Improvement District (Ordinance 17248);
- 15. Old Town Business Improvement District (Ordinance 18208);
- 16. Pacific Beach Business Improvement District (Ordinances 18373; 18542); and
- 17. San Ysidro Business Improvement District (Ordinance 18612); and

WHEREAS, California Streets and Highways Code section 36530 requires the Council to appoint a business or merchants association (Association) as an advisory board for each 1989 Act District to, among other things, provide recommendations to the City on the expenditure of assessment revenues; and

WHEREAS, Council Policy 900-07 provides for the Council to appoint an advisory board for each 1989 Act District on an annual basis, as part of the Council's annual confirmation of each 1989 Act District's budget; and

WHEREAS, as required by California Streets and Highways Code section 36533, the Fiscal Year 2017 Association appointed by the Council as the advisory board for each 1989 Act District, respectively, submitted an annual report (Budget Report) to the Council covering the time period commencing on July 1, 2017, and continuing through and including June 30, 2018 (Fiscal Year 2018);

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Parking and Business Improvement Area Law of 1965 (California Streets and Highways Code sections 36000-36081), that certain parking and business improvement area named the "Downtown Improvement Area" ("Downtown District") was established by and in the City of San Diego (Ordinances 10450; 10774) to annually levy and collect assessments on businesses located within the specified area to finance certain improvements and activities within such area (the 1989 Act Districts and the Downtown District

are sometimes each, individually, referred to in this Resolution as a "District" and, collectively, as the "Districts");

WHEREAS, for administrative consistency with the 1989 Act Districts, the City requires an annual Budget Report for the Downtown District to be submitted to the Council in the same manner as required for the 1989 Act Districts and approves such report; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2017 Association appointed by the Council as the advisory board for the Downtown District submitted a Budget Report to the Council for Fiscal Year 2018; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The Fiscal Year 2018 Budget Report for each District, including a description of the specific District, the boundaries of the District and any benefit zones within the District, the proposed assessments to be levied upon businesses within the District, and the improvements and activities to be undertaken within the District during Fiscal Year 2018, is approved, as on file and available for review at the Office of the City Clerk with reference to the following document numbers:
