A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE FIRE-RESCUE DEPARTMENT TO SEEK FULL REIMBURSEMENT OF RESCUE PERSONNEL WHILE ON OUT-OF-JURISDICTION EMERGENCY RESPONSES.

WHEREAS, the Fire-Rescue Department personnel respond to State and Federal emergency incidents throughout California as a California Fire and Rescue Mutual Aid System Agency; and

WHEREAS, the costs of these responses is reimbursed pursuant to the California Fire Assistance Agreement (CFAA); and

WHEREAS, beginning with the 2015 CFAA, rescue personnel will continue to be reimbursed for this portal to portal time but the CFAA now requires the responding agency to have a resolution in place spelling out portal to portal pay requirements; and

WHEREAS, Exhibit "A" section A-8.2 of the 2015 CFAA requires any agency seeking reimbursement of personnel for more than actual hours worked on the incident to file an MOU/MOA, governing body resolution, or other equivalent document with the California Office of Emergency Services Fire and Rescue Division for approval; and

WHEREAS, the MOU/MOA, governing body resolution, or other equivalent document shall indicate how agency personnel will be paid; and

WHEREAS, currently, all Fire-Rescue Department Personnel are paid portal to portal in accordance with the Local 145 and Local 911 MOUs, City personnel salary rates, and City fringe benefits; and

WHEREAS, approval of this item will allow the City's General fund to be fully

reimbursed for the portal to portal time of all Fire-Rescue Department employees responding to

emergencies out of jurisdiction under the CFAA; and

WHEREAS, response under the CFAA is on an as needed basis which hinders estimating

exact reimbursement costs to the City; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that all SDFD personnel,

including all firefighter and lifeguard classifications within the SDFD, shall be compensated in

accord with their MOU, City Personnel Rules and Regulations, and any other directive that

identifies personnel compensation in the workplace.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, in the event a SDFD personnel classification does not

have an assigned compensation rate, a "Base Rate" as set forth in an organizational policy,

administrative directive, or similar documents will do to compensate such personnel.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the SDFD shall maintain a current salary survey or

acknowledgement of acceptance of the "Base Rate" on file with the California Governor's Office

of Emergency Services, Fire Rescue Division.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, SDFD personnel shall be compensated portal to portal

beginning at the time of dispatch up until the time of return to their assigned jurisdiction when

equipment and personnel and in service and available for agency response.
