A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT SECURING GRANT FUNDING FROM CALTRANS FOR THE FAIRMOUNT AVENUE WEST AND EAST BRIDGES OVER ALDINE DRIVE PROJECT IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15061(B)(3).

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego plans to apply for and secure Highway Bridge

Program grant funding from the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) for a project
to rehabilitate the Fairmount Avenue West and East Bridges over Aldine Drive (Project); and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has determined that the application for and securing of grant funding for the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3) and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of the application for and securing of grant funding for the Project; and

WHEREAS, on JUN 2 7 2017, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the application for and securing of grant funding for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has determined that the actions of applying for and securing grant funding for the Project will not result in a significant effect on the environment; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego determines that the application for and securing of grant funding for the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3) and that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
