A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO EXPANDING THE SHERMAN HEIGHTS BANNER DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, section 142.1210(b)(5)(C) of the Municipal Code of the City of San Diego allows the placement of banners promoting cultural or civic events or activities of general public interest on streets and public rights-of-way designated by resolution of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, on October 8, 2010, by resolution R-306167, the City Council authorized and established the Sherman Heights Banner District; and

WHEREAS, the Sherman Heights Community Center Corporation is a non-profit civic organization founded to promote the enhancement of the quality of life and promote cultural diversity in the Sherman Heights community; and

WHEREAS, the Sherman Heights Community Center Corporation wishes to expand the area of the public right-of-way in which street banners may be installed to promote cultural and civic events, and community activities of general public interest; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego wishes to aid this civic endeavor; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

 In accordance with San Diego Municipal Code section 142.1210(b)(5)(C), the Sherman Heights Community Center Corporation may install banners along 25<sup>th</sup> Street from "G" Street to Kearney Avenue, along Market Street from 19<sup>th</sup> Street to 33<sup>rd</sup> Street, and along Island Avenue from 22<sup>nd</sup> Street to 25<sup>th</sup> Street.

- 2. The banners shall be installed in accordance with the following:
  - a. The banners shall not be used for commercial or political advertising, except that logos and trademarks of sponsoring organizations shall be permitted.
  - b. The total area of logos and trademarks shall be limited to five percent of the banner area.
  - c. The banners shall be displayed for no more than thirty calendar days, with one thirty-calendar-day extension.
  - d. The banners shall be installed only on light standards that have been equipped by a City approved contractor with approved mounting hardware.
  - e. The banners have received all necessary permits to locate in the public right-of-way.
