A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE EXCHANGE OF EASEMENTS BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AND AUTHORIZING THE GRANT OF A QUITCLAIM DEED TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA REGARDING EASEMENT INTERESTS IN REAL PROPERTY LOCATED WITHIN THE TORREY PINES STATE RESERVE NEEDED FOR THE WATER GROUP 939 PROJECT.

WHEREAS, in 1948 the City of San Diego (City) acquired a 30-foot easement for access road and waterline purposes (Original Easement) within the Torrey Pines State Reserve (APN 310-110-20), from the State of California's (State) predecessor in interest; and

WHEREAS, a waterline was never installed within the Original Easement area by the City, but an access road was established; and

WHEREAS, due to a landslide, a portion of the access road ended up deviating outside of the Original Easement's boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Water Group 939 Project (Project) proposes to locate a waterline within the existing deviated access road's boundaries, which eliminates the need for a portion of the Original Easement; and

WHEREAS, based on the boundaries of the existing deviated access road, a new easement (New Easement) was sought to grant the City easement rights over that portion of the existing deviated access road that is outside of the Original Easement; and

WHEREAS, to accommodate the Project, the New Easement was acquired from the State pursuant to San Diego Municipal Code section 22.3110 (Acquisition of Interests in Real Property), and is on file with the San Diego County Recorder's Office as Document No. 2017-0254278; and

WHEREAS, because the portion of the Original Easement which now lays outside of the

existing deviated access road is no longer needed, staff proposes that the excess area be

quitclaimed back to the State, by quitclaiming the excess area back to the State, via a quitclaim

deed (Quitclaim Deed), in exchange for the New Easement; and

WHEREAS, on March 1, 2017, a qualified real estate appraiser conducted an appraisal of

the easement interests proposed to be exchanged. Based on the appraisal, the Mayor certifies that

the easement interests in the New Easement and the easement interests in the Quitclaim Deed are

approximately equal in value; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the exchange of

the City's easement interests in the Original Easement for those easement interests in the New

Easement are approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized and

directed to execute that certain Quitclaim Deed in favor of the State of California, which is on

file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document Number RR-

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute

and deliver all other instruments to effect and complete the transaction contemplated by this

Resolution.
