DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUL 25 2017

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, APPROPRIATE, AND EXPEND UP TO \$1 MILLION PER YEAR IN GRANT FUNDS FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE UNDER THE EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program allows units of local government to support a broad range of activities to prevent and control crime based on local needs and conditions; and

WHEREAS, JAG funds may be used for state and local initiatives, technical assistance, strategic planning, research and evaluation (including forensics), data collection, training, personnel, equipment, forensic laboratories, supplies, contractual support, and criminal justice information systems; and

WHEREAS, JAG funds may support law enforcement programs; prosecution and court programs, including indigent defense; prevention and education programs; corrections, community corrections, and reentry programs; drug treatment and enforcement programs; planning, evaluation, and technology improvement programs; and crime victim and witness programs, other than providing compensation; and

WHEREAS, in August 2012, the San Diego Police Department (SDPD) requested and obtained authorization to apply for, appropriate, and expend JAG funds for a period of up to five years (San Diego Resolution R-307631 (Aug. 13, 2012)); and

WHEREAS, this request will allow SDPD to apply for, appropriate, and expend JAG funds for up to five additional years; and

WHEREAS, if grant funds are awarded to SDPD, the funds will be used to purchase supplemental equipment to outfit officers with effective urban crime fighting tools; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to apply for and take all necessary actions to secure up to \$1 million per year from the U.S. Department of Justice, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program, including any amendments, extensions, or renewals for a period of up to five years, provided funding is secured and made available.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend U.S. Department of Justice, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program funds, and any amendments, extensions, or renewals for a period of up to five years, from October 1, 2017, to September 30, 2022, provided funding is secured and made available.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing account for the grant funds, if required.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept an amount not to exceed \$1 million per year, for the purpose of implementing the JAG Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police or her designee is authorized to administer the U.S. Department of Justice, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program.
