- 2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate, transfer, and expend District funds, including the management fund, district operating funds, district capital funds, and developer deposit funds associated with new District formation activities for Fiscal Year 2018, contingent upon approval of the Fiscal Year 2018 Appropriation Ordinance, and contingent upon the City Comptroller certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are or will be available.
- 3. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to manually bill and collect assessments which are not billed by the County of San Diego, in the same time and manner as county taxes

are collected, and all laws providing for the collection and enforcement of county taxes shall apply to the collection and enforcement of the assessments.
