A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE ANNUAL REPORTS
SUBMITTED IN CONNECTION WITH THE CITY-MANAGED
MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT DISTRICTS FOR FISCAL
YEAR 2018 AND RELATED FUNDING ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, the Maintenance Assessment Districts specified below (individually, a District and collectively, the City-managed MADs) are existing districts as defined in San Diego Municipal Code section 65.0202 and are authorized and administered in accordance with the following laws, as applicable: Article XIID of the California Constitution, the Proposition 218 Omnibus Implementation Act (California Government Code sections 53750-53758), and the Maintenance Assessment District Procedural Ordinance (San Diego Municipal Code sections 65.0201-65.0222); and

WHEREAS, before the City formed each District, an assessment engineer prepared written reports (Engineer's Reports) that describe, among other things, the improvements and activities to be undertaken, the assessment rates and basis for calculations, and the properties to be assessed, for the following City-managed MADs:

WHEREAS, each Annual Report conforms to the above-referenced authority and has been duly considered by the City Council; and


WHEREAS, there are no proposed increases to the assessments, other than those authorized at the time of formation, including increases based on the San Diego Consumer Price Index; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. Each Fiscal Year 2018 Annual Report submitted for the City-managed MADs, on file and available for review in the Office of the City Clerk as listed above, is approved as filed.
2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate, transfer, and expend District funds, including the management fund, district operating funds, district capital funds, and developer deposit funds associated with new District formation activities for Fiscal Year 2018, contingent upon approval of the Fiscal Year 2018 Appropriation Ordinance, and contingent upon the City Comptroller certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are or will be available.
3. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to manually bill and collect assessments which are not billed by the County of San Diego, in the same time and manner as county taxes

are collected, and all laws providing for the collection and enforcement of county taxes shall apply to the collection and enforcement of the assessments.
