A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT APPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS TO THE MUNICIPAL CODE AND THE LOCAL COASTAL PROGRAM REGARDING SECOND UNITS IN A SINGLE-FAMILY OR MULTIFAMILY RESIDENTIAL ZONE, KNOWN AS COMPANION UNITS, TO IMPLEMENT PROVISIONS OF GOVERNMENT CODE SECTIONS 65852.1 AND 65852.2 IS EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO SECTION 15282(h) OF THE CEQA GUIDELINES.

WHEREAS, California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) Section 15282(h) provides that CEQA does not apply the adoption of an ordinance regarding second units in a single-family or multifamily residential zone by a city or county to implement the provisions Sections 65852.1 and 65852.2 of the Government Code as set for in section 21080.17 of the Public Resources Code; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego desires to amend to its companion unit regulations in the Municipal Code to comply with the new State mandate regarding accessory dwelling units set forth in Sections 65852.1 and 65852.2 of the Government Code (Project); and

WHEREAS, the amendments reduce requirements for parking, zoning setbacks, fire sprinklers, public utilities and fees; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has established that the Project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15282(h) and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects and considerations of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the

written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has

determined that the Project is exempt from CEQA, pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent

judgment, has considered the written record and public comment for the requested authorization,

and determines that the Project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section

15282(h).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego has

determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2

does not apply.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to file a Notice of

Exemption regarding the Project with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the County of

San Diego.
