A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO APPROVE THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE 2016 REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (RTIP).

WHEREAS, the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) as a Metropolitan Planning Organization and the Regional Transportation Planning Agency is required to develop a Regional Transportation Improvement Plan (RTIP); and

WHEREAS, the RTIP is a multi-year program of proposed projects for major highway, arterial, transit, pedestrian, and bikeway projects including the Transnet program of projects; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Transportation Improvement Ordinance provides that SANDAG periodically approve a multi-year program of eligible projects submitted by local agencies identifying those transportation projects eligible to use transportation sales tax (Transnet) funds; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires to submit a revised list of RTIP projects to SANDAG for Fiscal Years 2018 through 2022; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor, or his designee, request that SANDAG make the following changes to its 2016 Program of Projects (POP) ("the Amendment"), outlined in the resolutions to follow and as noted on the Attachment, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 311288

- 2. That pursuant to Section 2(C)(1) of the TransNet Extension Ordinance, the City of San Diego certifies that no more than 30 percent of its annual revenues shall be spent on local street and road maintenance-related projects as a result of the Amendment.
- 3. That pursuant of Section 4(E)(3) of the TransNet Extension Ordinance, the City of San Diego certifies that all new or changed projects, or major reconstruction projects, included in the Amendment and funded by TransNet revenues shall accommodate travel by pedestrians and bicyclist, and that any exception to this requirement permitted under the Ordinance and proposed, shall be clearly noticed as part of the City of San Diego's public hearing process for the Amendment.
- 4. That the City of San Diego does hereby certify that all applicable provisions of the TransNet Extension Ordinance and SANDAG Board Policy No. 31 have been met.
- 5. That City of San Diego continues to agree to indemnify, hold harmless, and defend SANDAG, the San Diego County Regional Transportation Commission, and all officers and employees thereof against all causes of action or claims to local TransNet funded projects.
