A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO GRANTING THE APPEAL OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION FOR 10715 SORRENTO VALLEY MEDICAL MARIJUANA CONSUMER COOPERATIVE – PROJECT NO. 527802.

WHEREAS, 10715 Sorrento Valley Medical Marijuana Consumer Cooperative filed an application with the City of San Diego for a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) for a Medical Marijuana Consumer Cooperative (MMCC), Project No. 527802 (Project); and

WHEREAS, on May 19, 2017, the Environmental Analysis Section of the Development Services Department determined the Project to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under the CEQA Guidelines section 15303, New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures (Environmental Determination) and a Notice of Right to Appeal the environmental determination was posted; and

WHEREAS, on June 2, 2017, Preston Eggleston, filed an appeal of the Environmental Determination (Appeal); and

WHEREAS, the Appeal was set for a public hearing to be conducted by the City Council of the City of San Diego on September 12, 2017, testimony having been heard, evidence having been submitted, and the City Council having fully considered the matter and being fully advised concerning the same; and

WHEREAS, a project is exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines section 15303(c) if it involves the construction of new small facilities or structures and the "conversion of existing small structures from one use to another where only minor modifications are made in the exterior of the structure;" and

WHEREAS, section 15303 lists examples of projects, including projects in urbanized areas, "up to four . . . commercial buildings in urbanized areas not exceeding 10,000 square feet

in floor area on sites zoned for such use if not involving the use of significant amounts of

hazardous substances where all necessary public services and facilities are available and the

surrounding area is not environmentally sensitive," which would be exempt; and

WHEREAS, the project site is located in the floodway fringe (Special Flood Hazard Area

Zone AE – 100 year), which falls under the San Diego Municipal Code classification of

Environmentally Sensitive Lands; and

WHEREAS, the surrounding area of the site is environmentally sensitive; and

WHEREAS, under San Diego Charter section 280(a)(2), this resolution is not subject to

veto by the Mayor because this matter requires the City Council to act as a quasi-judicial body

and where a public hearing was required by law implicating due process rights of individuals

affected by the decision and where the City Council was required by law to consider evidence at

the hearing and to make legal findings based on the evidence presented; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Appeal is

granted and the Environmental Determination is set aside.
