A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO CONFIRMING APPOINTMENTS AND REAPPOINTMENTS TO THE ETHICS COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the Ethics Commission (Commission) is established in the San Diego Municipal Code under Chapter 2, Article 6, Division 4 to monitor, administer, and enforce the City's governmental ethics laws, and other duties set forth in that Division; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code provides that the Commission shall consist of seven members appointed by the Mayor from a pool of nominees submitted by the members of the City Council and City Attorney, and subject to confirmation by a majority of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code provides that the members shall serve staggered fouryear terms; each member shall serve until a successor is duly appointed and confirmed; and all terms must have expiration dates of June 30; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code provides that the Commission shall reflect the diversity of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code was recently amended and requires that: (1) priority consideration is to be given to nominees with familiarity and experience with campaign finance laws, government ethics and lobbying laws, and conflict of interest regulations; (2) at least two of the members of the Commission shall have been a candidate for an elective governmental office, have worked as a treasurer or in another high-level position in a campaign for elective governmental office, or have held elective governmental office; and (3) at least three of the

members of the Commission are to be attorneys in good standing with the State Bar of California; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code also requires that no more than three members of the Commission shall be registered with the same political party; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code also requires that no person who ran as a candidate against a current elected City Official, or who served in a staff capacity for the campaign of such a candidate, shall be eligible for nomination to the Commission; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the following appointments and reappointments by the Mayor of the City of San Diego, to serve as members of the Ethics Commission, for terms expiring as indicated, are made and hereby confirmed:
