DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE OCT 25 2017

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING RENEWAL OF SLURRY SEAL
GROUP 1703 CONTRACT WITH AMERICAN ASPHALT
SOUTH, INC. AND THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS.

WHEREAS, San Diego City Council Resolution R-311004 authorized awarding a contract for street maintenance for the Slurry Seal Group 1703 project in an amount not to exceed \$5,000,000; and

WHEREAS, the contract was awarded to American Asphalt South, Inc. as the lowest responsible and reliable bidder; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to exercise the option to renew the contract with American Asphalt South in order to perform approximately 52 additional miles of maintenance, at an estimated cost of \$3,903,647.74 for the contract and \$1,096,352.26 for project and construction management, which would require increasing the maximum expenditure amount for the project from \$5,000,000 to \$10,000,000; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to renew the street maintenance contract for Slurry Seal Group 1703 with American Asphalt South, Inc. for the Slurry Seal Group 1703 project.

2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$5,000,000 from Fund 200118, Gas Tax Fund, for the purpose of funding the renewal of the Slurry Seal Group 1703 street maintenance contract and related administration costs, contingent

upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasury.



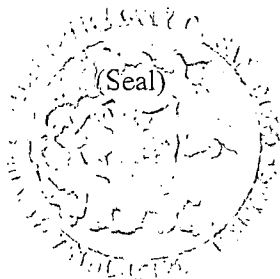
