A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE REMOVAL OF METERED PARKING SPACES ALONG UNIVERSITY AVENUE AND THE INSTALLATION OF ANGLE PARKING ON 8TH AVENUE, 10TH AVENUE, AND ESSEX STREET.

WHEREAS, bicycle lanes along University Avenue are prescribed in the Bicycle Master Plan and the Uptown Community Plan, and the proposed bicycle lanes will make it safer for cyclists riding along this corridor; and

WHEREAS, installing these bicycle lanes will require the removal of twenty-nine (29) metered parking spaces on University Avenue; and

WHEREAS, to offset the loss of parking on University Avenue, forty-eight (48) additional parking spaces will be created on neighboring streets with the installation of angle parking;

WHEREAS, the installation of angle parking at these locations shall be in accordance with San Diego Municipal Code section 86.0104 and California Vehicle Code section 22503; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the removal of twenty-nine (29) metered parking spaces on University Avenue between 6th Avenue and Vermont Street is authorized.
- 2. That the installation of angle parking on the on the west side of 8th Avenue between University Avenue and Washington Street to provide eleven (11) additional parking spaces is authorized.

3. That the installation of angle parking on the east and west side of 10th Avenue between the SR 163 On-Ramp and University Avenue to provide eight (8) additional parking

spaces is authorized.

4. That the installation of ninety-degree parking on the north side of Essex Street

between 10th Avenue and Vermont Street to provide fourteen (14) additional parking spaces is

authorized.

5. That the installation of ninety-degree parking on the north side of Essex Street

between Vermont Street and Richmond Street to provide fifteen (14) additional parking spaces is

authorized.

6. That the installation of necessary signs and markings for such angle parking is

authorized, and the regulations shall become effective on installation of signs.

7. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed

\$14,000 from General Fund 100000, Transportation & Storm Water – Street Division's (211611)

operating budget for the installation of angle parking and ninety-degree parking at the above

locations, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing a certificate certifying that

funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
