A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING A PROPOSITION I GRANT FUNDING APPLICATION FOR THE EL MONTE VALLEY LAND ACQUISITION AND RELATED ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, the San Diego River Conservancy is authorized to allocate \$17 million from Proposition 1 funds to address water quality, supply, and watershed protection and restoration in the region; and

WHEREAS, the Public Utilities Department (PUD) desires to adopt a resolution to submit an application to the San Diego River Conservancy Proposition 1 Grant Program to obtain grant funding pursuant to the Water Quality, Supply, and Infrastructure Improvement Act of 2014 (Proposition 1), enter into an agreement to receive the grant funding if awarded, and enter into a Purchase and Sale agreement to secure the El Monte Valley property; and

WHEREAS, the purchase price of the desired property will be \$975,000, which will be reimbursed to the City of San Diego through the San Diego River Conservancy Proposition 1 Grant Program, and this purchase price is based on fair market value, as established by an approved appraisal, and acquisition costs will be reimbursed through grant funding; in the event the grant is not awarded, PUD will evaluate whether or not to proceed with the purchase without grant funding; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to apply for, accept, and execute a grant application to the San Diego River Conservancy Proposition 1 Grant Program pursuant to the Water Quality, Supply, and Infrastructure Improvement Act of 2014, Proposition 1, for the acquisition of lands in El Monte Valley in an amount not to exceed \$975,000.

- 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$975,000 from the San Diego River Conservancy Grant Program pursuant to the Water Quality, Supply, and Infrastructure Improvement Act of 2014, Proposition 1, if grant funding is secured.
- 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing account for the grant, if needed.
- 4. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized, as agent, to enter into a Real Estate Purchase and Sale Agreement between the City of San Diego, San Diego River Conservancy and the Helix Water District to acquire certain portions of APNS 391-060-29, 391-061-01, 390-040-51, 392-130-42, totaling approximately 37.08 acres; and is authorized to execute and deliver all such agreement and all other instruments to effect and complete the transaction contemplated by this Resolution, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing a certificate certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the San Diego City Treasurer.
