WHEREAS, HomeFed Otay Land II, LLC, desires to acquire approximately 11.433 acres of City-owned land, Assessor's Parcel Number 644-070-20 and a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 644-080-19, subject to a reservation of easements for existing City water pipelines installed on the property located in the City of Chula Vista, County of San Diego, pursuant to the terms and conditions of that certain Purchase and Sale Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-311439 (Project); and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15312 (Surplus

Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential

environmental effects, if any, of the Project; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent

judgment, has considered the written record concerning the Project as well as public comment, if

any, and determines that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA

Guidelines section 15312 and that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA

Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
