A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO PURSUANT TO SECTION 147(f) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986 APPROVING THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF A NOTE BY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO OR THE CALIFORNIA MUNICIPAL FINANCE AUTHORITY FOR SEABREEZE FARMS & TORREY HIGHLANDS.

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the City of San Diego (Authority) or the California Municipal Finance Authority (CMFA) intends to execute and deliver a multifamily housing revenue note in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$20,500,000 (Note) to finance the acquisition, rehabilitation and equipping of "Seabreeze Farms & Torrey Highlands," 38-unit and 76-unit multifamily rental housing projects in the City of San Diego (City) described in the Notice of Public Hearing attached as Exhibit A hereto (Project); and

WHEREAS, in order for interest on the Note to be tax-exempt, section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (Code) requires that the Note be approved by the City Council as the applicable elected representative after a public hearing following reasonable public notice; and

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing with respect to the proposed execution and delivery of the Note was published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City on Friday, November 24, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing was held on December 11, 2017, and an opportunity was provided for interested persons to express their views on the execution and delivery of the Note and on the nature and location of the Project; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego that this City Council, as the applicable elected representative under section 147(f) of the Code, approves the execution and delivery of the Note by the Authority or CMFA.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City does not warrant the creditworthiness of the Note or guarantee, in any way, the payment of the Note. No moneys of the City will be pledged or applied to the repayment of the Note.
