A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO RATIFYING EIGHT (8) PUBLIC WORKS
EMERGENCY CONTRACTS

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) Public Works Department requests Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) ratification of eight (8) Public Works emergency contracts that were executed to address various infrastructure emergencies precipitated by the 2016-2017 rainy season storms and other emergency situations; and

WHEREAS, this action covers seven (7) contracts awarded in Fiscal Year 2017 and one (1) contract from Fiscal Year 2016; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code (SDMC) Section 22.3108 of the SDMC provides that public works contracts may be awarded without advertisement and competition when the public interest or necessity demands the immediate expenditure of public money to safeguard life, health, or property due to extraordinary fire, flood, storm, epidemic, or other disaster, provided that the Mayor immediately reports the emergency award to the City Council and describes the justifications therefor in writing, and the City Council subsequently ratifies the award by resolution of a two-thirds vote; and


WHEREAS, in accordance with SDMC section 22.3108, for each emergency contract identified, the Public Works Department issued a memorandum notifying the City Council of the emergency condition at issue and certifying that the contract was necessary in order to perform the applicable emergency maintenance and repairs; and

WHEREAS, ratification of these emergency contracts requires a resolution passed by a two-thirds vote of the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:



That the Council hereby ratifies the emergency infrastructure repair contracts necessitated by the 2016-2017 rainy season weather conditions and other emergency situations, as listed in Attachment A, which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. 311468.

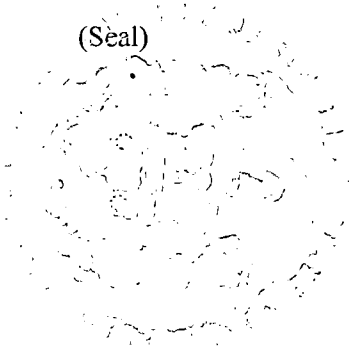
