AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING TWO PROGRAM MANAGER POSITIONS IN THE TRANSPORTATION AND STORM WATER DEPARTMENT FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2017, the City of San Diego (City)'s Civil Service

Commission reviewed a request from the City's Transportation and Storm Water Department

(Department) to exempt two Program Manager positions from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the Program Manager in the Storm Water Division will oversee the Long Range Planning and Asset Management Program; and

WHEREAS, this position will plan and implement storm water goals, monitor compliance and storm drain maintenance activities, and identify division funding needs; develop program implementation strategies and assessments; provide policy direction on the development of long-range storm water compliance plans and related asset management plans; determine negotiating strategies with regulatory agencies and key stakeholders; and provide policy direction and coordination on how the City will comply with storm water obligations related to water quality compliance targets; and

WHEREAS, the Program Manager in the Transportation Engineering Operations

Division will assist with the management and execution of division programs to include the Bike

Master Plan, the City's Vision Zero Program, the transportation goals identifies in the Climate

Action Plan, the Downtown Mobility Plan, transportation Capital Improvement Projects, and the

Bridge Program; and

WHEREAS, this position will provide day-to-day oversight, coordination, and monitoring of programs and will report progress to the Mayor, City Council, and stakeholders.

This position will coordinate with other City departments on programs to ensure the resolution of safety issues; assist the Deputy Director with future policies and strategic plans; and supervise four sections within the division; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Charter (Charter) section 117(a)(17) states that the Unclassified Service shall include "[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council"; and

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2017, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the Program Manager positions, as provided by the Department, the Civil Service Commission determined that the positions meet the standard set forth in Charter section 117(a)(17) to be placed in the Unclassified Service; and

WHEREAS, the determinations of the Civil Service Commission are set forth in a memorandum dated December 21, 2017, from Hadi Dehghani, Personnel Director, to the Honorable Council President and City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the City Council has received and reviewed a memorandum from Personnel Director Hadi Dehghani, dated December 21, 2017, which documents that, on December 12, 2017, the City's Civil Service Commission reviewed and favorably commented on a proposal from the Department to exempt two Program Manager positions from the Classified Service, one in the Storm Water Division overseeing the Long Range Planning and Asset Management Program and the second in the Transportation Engineering Operations division working on several programs, as outlined in the December 21, 2017 memorandum.

Section 2. That pursuant to Charter section 117(a)(17), with the Civil Service Commission's review and approval, the City Council exempts from the Classified Service and declares to be in the Unclassified Service of the City two Program Manager positions, performing the duties set forth in the December 21, 2017, memorandum from Personnel Director Hadi Dehghani to the Honorable Council President and City Council, and in this ordinance.

Section 3. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
