DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE FEB 2 8 2018

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A MASTER LEASE AGREEMENT WITH BANC OF AMERICA PUBLIC CAPITAL CORP. FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING THE ACQUISITION AND OUTFITTING OF A FIRE HELICOPTER IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$20,000,000, AND TAKING OTHER ACTIONS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, from time to time the City of San Diego (City) acquires projects and equipment for the purpose of providing public services using lease-purchase financing arrangements under the City's Equipment and Vehicle Financing Program (EVFP); and

WHEREAS, on December 13, 2017, the City Council adopted Resolution No. R-311475, approving the purchase of a Sikorsky S-70i helicopter (Equipment) to be operated by the San Diego Fire-Rescue Department; and

WHEREAS, on December 13, 2017, the City Council adopted Resolution No. R-311476, declaring the official intent of the City to reimburse itself from the proceeds of tax-exempt lease-purchase obligations related to the purchase of the Equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor now recommends entering into a Master Lease Agreement (Agreement) with Banc of America Public Capital Corp. (BAPCC) in an amount not to exceed \$20,000,000 to finance the acquisition and outfitting of the Equipment and to pay related expenses through a lease-purchase arrangement under the EVFP; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement requires an opinion of tax counsel where the acquisition cost of financed equipment exceeds \$10,000,000 and the total projected cost of the Equipment is approximately \$20,000,000; and

WHEREAS, the City currently has an agreement with Nixon Peabody LLP (Firm) to provide legal and tax advice related to the EVFP (EVFP Agreement) and the Firm is willing and able to provide the required tax opinion; and

WHEREAS, the EVFP Agreement is set to expire on June 20, 2018 and staff request authorization to extend the contract for an additional year to June 20, 2019; and

WHEREAS, staff requests that the not-to-exceed amount in the agreement with the Firm be increased by \$5,000 to accommodate the fee for the tax opinion and any related legal advice; and

WHEREAS, under San Diego Charter section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by an ordinance adopted by a two-thirds majority of the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized and directed to finance the cost of acquiring the Equipment using a Master Lease Agreement with BAPCC.
- Section 2. That the Mayor, the Chief Operating Officer, the Chief Financial Officer or any of their designees is hereby authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City of San Diego, a Master Lease Agreement with BAPCC for the purpose of financing the acquisition of the Equipment. The Master Lease Agreement shall be substantially in the form presented to this Council, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No.
- 00-20906, with such additions and changes therein as the Chief Operating Officer or

Chief Financial Officer, in consultation with the City Attorney, shall approve as being in the best

interest of the City; provided however that: (i) the acquisition and related costs of equipment

financed under the Master Lease Agreement shall not exceed \$20,000,000; (ii) the interest rate

shall not exceed six percent (6%) annually; and (iii) the lease term of the Master Lease

Agreement shall not exceed 10 years.

That the City Attorney is authorized to amend the EVFP Agreement with

Nixon Peabody LLP to increase the amount authorized by \$5,000 and to extend the term of the

agreement by one year to June 20, 2019.

That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a Section 4.
