DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE APR 25 2018

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH DAVY ARCHITECTURE FOR AS-NEEDED ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES; AND TAKING RELATED ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, on October 16, 2014, the City of San Diego entered into an agreement with Davy Architecture to provide As-Needed Architectural Design Services (H146174) (Agreement) for Capital Improvement Program (CIP) projects (Project); and

WHEREAS, seven (7) tasks have been issued as part of the contract with one task currently under design that has a completion date past the contract expiration and will exhaust the contract capacity; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by Ordinance approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City, the First Amendment to the Agreement with Davy Architecture, to increase the amount of compensation from \$1,000,000 to \$1,093,500, for as-needed architectural services, under the terms and conditions set forth in the First Amendment to the Agreement, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO 20925, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will, be on deposit with the City Treasury.

Section 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$1,093,500 over 87 months for the purpose of funding the as-needed architecture services and executing this amendment to the agreement with Davy Architecture, contingent upon the adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasury.


Section 3. That the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$1,093,500 over 87 months is authorized for the purpose of executing this First Amendment to the Agreement, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first certifying that funds are available for the above-referenced Project.

Section 4. That the Chief Financial Officer, upon advice from the administering department, is authorized to transfer excess funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.

Section 5. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 6. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
