AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH ARCHITECTS MOSHER DREW FOR AS-NEEDED ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES; AND TAKING RELATED ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, the City entered into a professional services agreement with Architects

Mosher Drew on November 10, 2014 to provide Architectural services for various Capital

Improvement Program projects; and

WHEREAS, there are six (6) tasks that have been issued as part of the contract and two (2) tasks that are currently under design with completion dates that will extend this contract past the contract's expiration date and a need for additional contract capacity; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by Ordinance approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City, the First Amendment to the Agreement with Architects Mosher Drew to increase the contract amount from \$1,000,000 to \$1,200,000 for as-needed architecture services for Capital Improvement Program projects, under the terms and conditions set forth in the First Amendment to the Agreement, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO 20926, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasury.

Section 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to

exceed \$1,200,000 over 72 months for the purpose of funding the as-needed architecture services

with Architects Mosher Drew, contingent upon the adoption of the Annual Appropriation

Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer

furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be,

on deposit with the City Treasury.

Section 3. That the Chief Financial Officer, upon advice from the administering

department, is authorized to transfer excess funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.

Section 4. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a

written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its

passage.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from

and after its final passage.
