ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 20935 (NEW SERIES)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING A TEN-MONTH EXTENSION TO THE AGREEMENT WITH SOCO GROUP, INC. FOR CITYWIDE FUEL CONSUMPTION.

WHEREAS, on January 10, 2012, the City Council approved Resolution No. R-307215 which authorized the award of a contract to The SOCO Group to furnish various fuels to the City (Contract) pursuant to Resolution No. R-307215; and

WHEREAS, the contract was extended on September 9, 2016, via ordinance, for a term of 18 months to secure the addition of renewable diesel fuel; and

WHEREAS, the contract is due to expire June 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to extend the contract by an additional ten months to ensure timely completion of a thorough Request for Proposal process and successful award of the contract; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by Ordinance approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the City Council; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City, the Third Amendment to Contract between The City of San Diego and The SoCo Group for Various Fuels, for the purpose of extending the term of the Contract through April 30, 2019, increasing the not-to-exceed amount of the Contract to \$10.2 million, and otherwise modifying the Contract pursuant to the terms and conditions contained in the Third Amendment to the Contract on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO-

Section 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not-to-exceed \$10.2 million during the term of the Contract, as amended, from funds as follows: Fleet Operations (720000) for \$9,400,000; Parks and Recreation (700043) for \$71,000; Fire-Rescue Department (100000) for \$92,500; Fire-Rescue Department (100000) for \$54,400; Public Utilities Department (700001) for \$90,400; and Environmental Services Department (700039) for \$491,700, for the purpose of funding the Contract, contingent upon the adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

Section 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to transfer excess funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves upon advice from the administering department.

Section 4. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
