

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 20946 (NEW SERIES)

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUN 14 2018

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE FOURTH AMENDMENT TO THE CONSULTANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND KLEINFELDER (FORMERLY SIMON WONG ENGINEERING, INC.) FOR THE GEORGIA STREET BRIDGE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, Kleinfelder (formerly Simon Wong Engineering, Inc.) entered into a consultant agreement with the City of San Diego to provide professional engineering services for the Replacement of the Georgia Street Bridge Over University Avenue Phase 1 (Project) on November 18, 2008, as Document No. RR-304379; and

WHEREAS, the First Amendment to the consultant agreement, entered into on November 9, 2011 as Document No. RR-307084, allowed for the completion of the requested Rehabilitation Report, additional field investigations, engineering coordination and preliminary engineering for the selected alternatives for the required environmental documents; and

WHEREAS, the Second Amendment to the consultant agreement, entered into on October 8, 2013 as Document No. RR-309525, allowed for the completion of the plans, specifications, and estimate and provided for limited construction support for the selected alternative; and

WHEREAS, the Third Amendment to the consultant agreement, entered into on August 4, 2017 as Document No. OO-20849, allowed for additional time and budget for construction support services for the remainder of construction of the Georgia Street Bridge; and

WHEREAS, the Fourth Amendment will provide time and budget for additional construction support and design services required for the remainder of the Georgia Street Bridge construction; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by Ordinance approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute the Fourth Amendment to the Consultant Agreement with Kleinfelder for engineering services under the terms and conditions set forth in the Amendment on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 20946, for Capital Improvement Project (CIP) S-00863, Georgia Street Bridge Improvements, in the amount not to exceed \$75,000.00.

Section 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$75,000.00 from CIP S-00863, Georgia Street Bridge Improvements, Fund 400169, TransNet Extension 70% CAP, for the purpose of executing the Fourth Amendment to the Consultant Agreement with Kleinfelder.

Section 3. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to make applications to Caltrans and take all necessary actions to secure funding in an amount not to exceed \$510,000.00 in Fund 600000, Grant Fund Federal, for the Georgia Street Bridge Improvements project, CIP S-00863.

Section 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase the Fiscal Year 2018 CIP Budget in CIP S-00863, Georgia Street Bridge Improvements, and to accept, appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$510,000.00, Fund 600000, Grant Fund Federal, for the purpose


of construction, contingent upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement if the grant funding is secured.

Section 5. That the Chief Financial Officer, upon advice from the administering department, is authorized to transfer excess funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.

Section 6. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 7. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
