DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE ALIG 0 3 2018

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DIRECTING THAT THE MIRAMAR LANDFILL BE CLOSED ON SUNDAYS AND ON THE THREE SUMMER HOLIDAYS OF MEMORIAL DAY, INDEPENDENCE DAY, AND LABOR DAY.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego's (City) Environmental Services Department (ESD) has determined that Miramar Landfill (Landfill) services are utilized approximately 50% of the time on Sundays, and approximately 42% of the time on the three summer holidays of Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Labor Day (Summer Holidays), as compared to typical weekday Landfill services; and

WHEREAS, closing the Landfill on Sundays and on the three Summer Holidays is expected to result in cost reductions and increased operational efficiencies, in that the Sunday and three Summer Holidays closures would improve staff coverage and customer service on weekdays, reduce equipment expenditures, reduce labor and overtime expenditures, reduce potential for injuries and associated loss of worktime, reduce potential Landfill odors consistent with San Diego Air Pollution Control District regulations, and provide cost savings to supply a funding mechanism for the City's Zero Waste Plan; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance would direct that the Landfill be closed on Sundays and on the three Summer Holidays, effective October 1, 2018, except in the case of public emergencies including, but not limited to, extraordinary fires, floods, storms, epidemics, and other disasters; and

WHEREAS, the Environment Committee heard this item on June 21, 2018, and recommended that the City Council approve the ordinance; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to San Diego City Charter section 26.1, these Landfill services

shall be provided under such terms and conditions as may be authorized by the City Council by

ordinance; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Miramar Landfill be closed on Sundays and on the three Summer

Holidays of Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Labor Day, effective as of October 1, 2018,

except in the case of public emergencies including, but not limited to, extraordinary fires, floods,

storms, epidemics, and other disasters.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, since a

written copy was made available to the City Council and the public prior to its day of passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from

and after its final passage.
