AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO RATIFYING A MODIFICATION TO THE MIRAMAR LANDFILL GROUND LEASE BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A MODIFICATION TO THE MIRAMAR LANDFILL GROUND LEASE BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

WHEREAS, the Miramar Landfill (Landfill) located at 5180 Convoy Street, San Diego, California 92111, was constructed in 1973, and is operated by the City of San Diego (City) under a 50-year Ground Lease (Lease) with the United States of America, acting by and through the Department of the Navy, administered by Marine Corp Air Station Miramar (collectively the "Government"); and

WHEREAS, the Lease was previously modified on September 21, 2007; September 29, 2008; and December 2, 2014; as further described in the staff report; and

WHEREAS, the California Integrated Waste Management Board has required the City to install six (6) gas monitoring probes around the perimeter of the Landfill to detect offsite gas migration; and

WHEREAS, the installation of these gas monitoring probes requires a modification to the Lease to add a total of approximately 18.84 square feet to the north and east of the existing City leasehold under the Lease (Gas Probe Modification); and

WHEREAS, in preparing the Gas Probe Modification it came to City staff's attention that the September 29, 2008 modification did not receive City Council approval; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by Ordinance approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the execution of the September 29, 2008 modification to the Ground Lease between the City of San Diego and the United States of America, acting by and through the Department of the Navy, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 20981, is authorized and hereby ratified.

Section 3. That a full reading of this Ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage, and no building permits for development inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance shall be issued unless application therefore was made prior to the date of adoption of this Ordinance.
