ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 21000 (NEW SERIES)

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE OCT 26 2018

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING ONE PROGRAM MANAGER
POSITION IN THE PUBLIC UTILITIES DEPARTMENT FROM
THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO.

WHEREAS, on September 6, 2018, the San Diego Civil Service Commission (Civil Service Commission) reviewed a request from the Public Utilities Department (Department) to exempt one Program Manager position from the Classified Service for the City of San Diego (City); and

WHEREAS, the Program Manager position will assist with managing regulatory compliance within the Environmental Monitoring and Technical Services Division; and

WHEREAS, this Program Manager position will lead the permit writing and waiver process coordination efforts for the Point Loma Wastewater Treatment Plant (PLWTP) to secure support for continued operation of the PLWTP at advanced primary treatment; review department initiatives, such as the City's Pure Water Program (Pure Water), before submitting National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirement permit applications; oversee the implementation of new monitoring regulations related to Pure Water; oversee the division's public outreach activities; work in conjunction with the division Deputy Director to assess newly established regulations and department vulnerabilities in order to develop department and City policies to minimize risk, protect the public, and enact effective monitoring programs; and oversee the Administration and Business Support Section, and the Data Management and Quality Assurance Section; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Charter (Charter) section 117 provides that the Unclassified Service shall include "[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating

and administering department policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempt from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council”; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the Program Manager, as described by the Department, the Civil Service Commission finds that the position meets the requirements in Charter section 117 to exempt the position from the Classified Service; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to Charter section 117(a) (17), the Department initiated advisory review and comment from the Civil Service Commission relating to the proposed exemption of a Program Manager position from the Classified Service, and the Civil Service Commission reviewed the proposed exemption on September 6, 2018, and commented favorably upon it, as meeting Charter criteria for placement of the position in the Unclassified Service. Having considered and reviewed the findings of the Civil Service Commission, as set forth in the Memorandum to the Honorable Council President and City Council, from Douglas Edwards, Personnel Director, on behalf of the Civil Service Commission, dated September 10, 2018, the Council now exempts from the Classified Service the Program Manager position, performing the specific duties described in the September 10, 2018 Memorandum, and declares the position to be in the Unclassified Service.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.

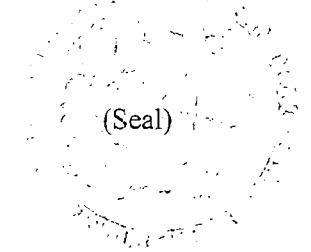

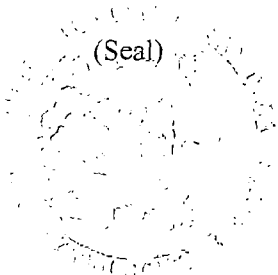
