DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE OCT 26 2018

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 2 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE, BY RETITLING DIVISION 19 AND AMENDING SECTION 22.1901; AND AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 6, DIVISION 00 BY AMENDING SECTION 26.09, RELATING TO CHANGING THE NAME OF THE DEPARTMENT OF INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS TO THE GOVERNMENT AFFAIRS DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, San Diego Charter section 26 provides for an administrative code that details the powers and duties of the administrative offices and departments of the City of San Diego (City); and

WHEREAS, the administrative code lists the Department of Intergovernmental Relations as a City department; and

WHEREAS, a description of the department and its duties is included in the San Diego Municipal Code (Municipal Code) section 22.1901; and

WHEREAS, an additional reference to the department is made in Municipal Code section 26.09; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor recommends the name of the department be changed to the "Government Affairs Department" consistent with contemporary language used by other organizations; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 26, Council must approve by a two-thirds vote an ordinance to establish new departments or combine existing departments in the Administrative Code; and

WHEREAS, the proposed amendments are now considered by the Council for adoption;  
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 2, Article 2, Division 19 of the San Diego Municipal Code is amended by retitling Division 19 and amending section 22.1901 to read as follows:

**Division 19: Government Affairs Department**

**§22.1901 Government Affairs Department**

The Government Affairs Department is a City department. The Director is the administrative head of the department and shall be selected by the City Manager. The Director shall be the appointing authority of all personnel authorized in the department. The Director shall be responsible for planning, recommending, coordinating and administering a state and federal legislative program for The City of San Diego in accordance with legislative guidelines established by City Council. The department shall provide legislative coordination and liaison and, in consultation with City departments, City organized or created entities, and other sources:

Section 2. That Chapter 2, Article 6, Division 00 is amended by amending section 26.09 to read as follows:

**§26.09 Select Board on Binational Issues**



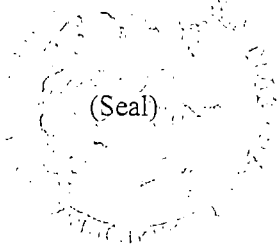

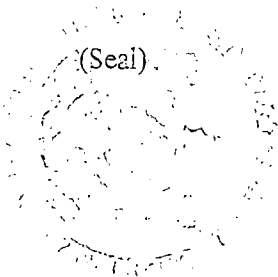
