A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE PURE WATER SAN DIEGO PROPOSTION 1 WATER STORAGE INVESTMENT PROGRAM GRANT APPLICATION.

WHEREAS, on April 29, 2014, the San Diego City Council adopted Resolution no. R-308906 supporting the Pure Water San Diego Program. Pure Water San Diego provides a new source of supply for the production of potable water for the City of San Diego (City), increases the amount of reclaimed water, and diverts wastewater flows from the ocean outfalls.

WHEREAS, Pure Water San Diego is a phased, multi-year program that will ultimately create up to 83 million gallons per day (mgd) or 93,000 acre-feet per year (AFY) of the city's water supply by 2035. Pure Water Phase One projects will produce 30 mgd of purified water and are anticipated to be completed by 2021.

WHEREAS, Phase One is estimated to cost approximately \$1.1 billion to \$1.3 billion. In an effort to obtain funding for this project, the City proposes to apply for up to \$219,310,000 in grant funds from the California Water Commission. The grant funds offered through the Water Storage Investment Program are for projects that provide public benefits associated with water storage projects to improve the operation of the state water system, are cost effective, and provide a net improvement in ecosystem and water quality conditions. Phase One of Pure Water will assist in the reduction of current and future water demands on the Bay Delta by developing local water supplies, improving self-reliance, ecosystem water quality, and other public benefits; and NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor or designee is authorized to make application to the California Water Commission and to take all necessary actions to secure funding in an amount not to exceed \$219,310,000 in Proposition 1 Water Storage Investment Program grant funds for the Pure Water San Diego Program, Phase One.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend an amount not to exceed \$219,310,000 from the Proposition 1 Water Storage Investment Program, if grant funding is secured.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing account for the grant, if required.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase the Capital Improvements Program Budget in CIP ALA-00001, Pure Water Program, and to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$219,310,000, Water Storage Investment Program, State Grant Fund 710001, for the purpose of funding the Pure Water San Diego Program, Phase one, contingent upon the receipt of a fully executed grant agreement.
