WHEREAS, certain work, such as trenching, installing conduits and cable, modification of electric meter panels, installing weather heads, meter cutover and similar activities, has to occur on private properties to prepare them to receive the converted underground power and communication services; and

WHEREAS, in the past, this work was performed by an SDG&E contractor, and the Surcharge Fund was used to reimburse SDG&E for this work.

WHEREAS, in 2014, SDG&E informed the City that, in order to streamline their processes, they would no longer be providing work on private property and requested the City to take over this work; and

WHEREAS, the work required on private property does not require detailed engineering design, and this work cannot be accomplished by City staff; therefore, a Job Order Contract (JOC) is necessary to accomplish this work; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute a JOC with the lowest responsible and reliable bidder for an amount not to exceed \$15,000,000 over a five year period, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-3115,08

that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

this JOC, contingent upon the adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable

certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditures are, or will be, on deposit with the

City Treasurer.

an amount not to exceed \$10,000 from Fund No. 200217, Underground Surcharge Fund,

Transportation & Storm Water Department, solely and exclusively, to provide funds meeting

minimum contract requirements for the project.
