A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING OPTION YEARS AND FUNDS ON CONTRACT WITH CALIFORNIA WATER TECHNOLOGIES TO PROVIDE FERROUS CHLORIDE FOR WASTEWATER FACILITIES IN THE PUBLIC UTILITIES DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the San Diego Public Utilities Department, Wastewater Treatment and Disposal Division requires ferrous chloride at the Point Loma Wastewater Treatment Plant,

Metropolitan Biosolids Center and North City Water Reclamation Plant;

WHEREAS, an Invitation to Bid (ITB), No. 10077844-17-V for the purchase of ferrous chloride was issued by San Diego Purchasing & Contracting Department on July 20, 2016.

Purchasing & Contracting Department received notice from five potential bidders who downloaded the bid from the City's third party provider. Upon closing, only two were responsive and evaluated. California Water Technologies had the lowest cost in response to the ITB.

WHEREAS, the Public Utilities Department has reached an agreement with California Water Technologies to provide ferrous chloride for Wastewater facilities in the Public Utilities now seeks authorization to approve remaining options years and additional funds; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor or designee is authorized to approve the remaining option years per the contract with California Water Technologies to provide ferrous chloride as required in an amount not to exceed \$8,025,880. The first year began in FY 2017 and the first Option Year was executed in FY 2018.

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There are three one-year options remaining, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer

furnishing a certificate certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit

with the City Treasurer; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend

a cumulative amount not to exceed \$8,025,880 on an as-required basis over the three one-year

options remaining in the contract, from the Metro Sewer Utility Fund 700001, for the purpose of

funding the chemical ferrous chloride with California Water Technology, contingent upon

adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year and contingent

upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds

necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer. The amount of

\$862,853 was spent in FY 2017 for the first year of the contract, and \$1,174,120 is encumbered

in FY 2018 Purchase Orders for the first Option Year, bringing the total contract amount to

\$10,062,853.
