A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION AND DISPLAY OF PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY BANNERS IN THE ROLANDO PARK AREA.

WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code section 142.1210(b)(5)(C) allows the placement of banners promoting cultural or civic events or activities of general public interest on streets and public rights-of-way designated by resolution of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Rolando Park Community Council is a non-profit civic organization founded to promote the enhancement of the quality of life in the Rolando Park neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, the Rolando Park Community Council wishes to install street banners in the public right-of-way promoting cultural and civic events, and community activities of general public interest; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego wishes to aid this civic endeavor; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

In accordance with Municipal Code section 142.1210(b)(5)(C), the Rolando Park
Community Council may install banners along the east side of College Avenue
from Livingston Street to University Avenue, along the south side of University
Avenue from College Avenue to 69th Street.

- 2. The banners shall be installed in accordance with the following:
  - a. The banners shall not be used for commercial or political advertising,
     except that logos and trademarks of sponsoring organizations shall be
     permitted.
  - b. The total area of logos and trademarks shall be limited to five percent of the banner area.
  - c. The banners shall be displayed for no more than thirty calendar days, with one 30-calendar-day extension.
  - d. The banners shall be installed only on light standards that have been equipped by the City with approved mounting hardware.
  - e. The banners have received all necessary permits to locate in the public right-of-way.
