DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE FEB 28 2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A
COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH CALTRANS FOR
MAINTENANCE OF THE ROSE CREEK BICYCLE PATH.

WHEREAS, the Rose Creek Bicycle Path is identified as a priority in the Regional
Bicycle Plan Early Action Program; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) is the lead agency
for design and construction and, upon completion, the bicycle path will be turned over to the City
of San Diego (City) as a City asset; and

WHEREAS, SANDAG will cover all costs for design and construction of the Rose Creek
Bicycle Path, consisting of \$21.6 million of TransNet funds and \$400,000 from the Federal
Highway Administration Transportation Enhancements Program; and


WHEREAS, an approximately 900 foot segment of the new bicycle path will pass under
Interstate Highway 5 through California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) right-of-way;
and

WHEREAS, the City will maintain this segment of bicycle path that is within Caltrans
right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, maintenance is expected to begin in Fiscal Year 2019 and is estimated to
cost approximately \$15,000 annually for the 2.1 mile project length, which includes
approximately \$1,200 for the 900 foot segment within Caltrans right-of-way subject to this
action. This maintenance work will be handled by city staff and funds are budgeted in the
General Fund (Fund 100000); NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to enter into a "Project Specific Maintenance Agreement for Rose Creek Bicycle Path in the City of San Diego" with Caltrans for that portion of the bicycle path passing under Interstate Highway 5 through Caltrans right-of-way.

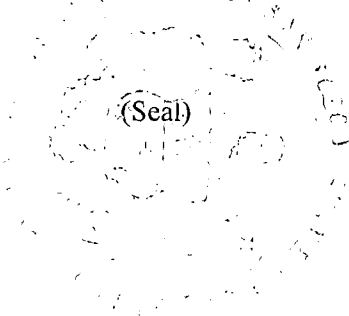
