A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT \$281,572 IN FY2017 STATE HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM FUNDING AND AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO APPROPRIATE AND EXPEND THESE GRANT FUNDS.

WHEREAS, State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSP) funds are issued annually by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA); and

WHEREAS, all 50 States, the District of Columbia, and designated territories were eligible to apply for FY2017 SHSP funds; and

WHEREAS, the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services applied directly to FEMA for FY2017 SHSP funds on behalf of State agencies and local jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, FEMA passes the allocated SHSP funds through the State of California to the County of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Diego Office of Emergency Services allocates a portion of the funds to the City of San Diego according to the City's number of sworn budgeted Law Enforcement officers; and

WHEREAS, the City's allocation of FY2017 SHSP funds is \$281,572; and WHEREAS, the City's Office of Homeland Security (OHS) will serve as the agent for

the City to receive and expend the FY2017 SHSP funds; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Police Department (SDPD) developed, and OHS submitted, a grant expenditure plan to procure equipment to strengthen SDPD's capabilities in information technology for critical infrastructure protection, and tactical response to terrorism incidents; and

WHEREAS, There is no non-federal match or cost share required for particaption in the

SHSP; and

WHEREAS, this grant is reimbursable in nature, requiring the City to expend funds prior

to requesting reimbursement; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or his

designee, is authorized to apply for and accept \$281,572 and any additional grant funding from

the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services via the County of San Diego Office of

Emergency Services to implement the FY2017 SHSP.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer, or his designee, is

authorized to appropriate and expend \$281,572 and any additional grant funding awarded under

the FY2017 State Homeland Security Grant Program, as well as execute all agreements

necessary for the purpose of implementing the FY2017 SHSP, contingent upon funding being

secured.
