A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE ELIMINATION, CANCELLATION, AND ANNULMENT OF THE DECLARATION OF RESTRICTIONS FOR SOUTH SAN DIEGO INDUSTRIAL PARK, UNIT 1 AS A WHOLE IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15061(B)(3).

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), states that CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300 – 15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego desires to authorize the elimination, cancellation, and annulment of the Declaration of Restrictions South San Diego Industrial Park, Unit 1 as a whole (Project); and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has established that the approval of the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3) and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to CEOA Section 15352(a), authorization to eliminate, cancel, and

annul the Declaration of Restrictions South San Diego Industrial Park, Unit 1 as a whole, does

not constitute approval of a project for which a future discretionary action and environmental

document would be required. This action will not foreclose review of alternatives or mitigation

measures by the public as part of any future CEQA process. Formal approval of a future project

will occur once an environmental review has been completed in accordance with the provisions

of CEQA Section 15004 and the City's Land Development Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the potential environmental effect of the

Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the

written record for the Project as well as public comment; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent

judgement, has considered the written record and public comment for the elimination,

cancellation, and annulment of the Declaration of Restrictions South San Diego Industrial Park,

Unit 1 as a whole, and determines that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant

to CEQA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3), and that an exception to the exemption as set forth in

CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
