A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING UP TO \$14,500 TO ALLIANCE FOR QUALITY EDUCATION FOR THE D6 NIGHT MARKET, PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-23, "CITY COUNCIL FUNDING FOR ARTS, CULTURE AND COMMUNITY FESTIVALS WITH DISCRETIONARY TRANSIENT OCCUPANCE TAX ALLOCATION."

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council (City Council) adopted Council Policy 100-23, entitled "City Council Funding of Arts, Culture and Community Festivals with Transient Occupancy Tax Allocation" on August 13, 2012, by San Diego Resolution R-307625; and

WHEREAS, among other things, Council Policy 100-23 provides a procedure and uniform requirements for awarding funds to and contracting with private non-profit organizations that produce programs, projects and events that (i) provide access to excellence in culture and the arts for residents of, and visitors to San Diego, and (ii) enrich the lives of the people of San Diego and build healthy, vital neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the Alliance for Quality Education has requested funding for the D6 Night Market; and

WHEREAS, the requested funding will be used for event support and supplies including marketing, outreach, permits, insurance, the entertainment stage, audio, lighting, security fencing and personnel, portable restrooms, handwashing stations, utility sinks, tables, and chairs; and

WHEREAS, the Alliance for Quality Education's request for funding for the D6 Night Market will benefit the public by ensuring that all children receive a quality education by

strengthening communities to act as catalysts to transform and revitalize public education. The Night Market is a free, family-friendly, and festive open-air event celebrating and benefiting the diverse neighborhoods of Council District 6. The District is home to over 140,000 people, many of whom have ethnically diverse backgrounds. The event celebrates this diversity and offers attendees local food and merchandise vendors, live cultural entertainment, civic engagement, economic development opportunities, senior and youth activities, a beer garden, and laser shows; and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described program fits within the parameters of Council Policy 100-23; and

WHEREAS, Council District 6 recommends an allocation of up to \$14,500 to the Alliance for Quality Education for the purposes set forth in this resolution; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocation described in this resolution is made for a public purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City, an Agreement between the City of San Diego and the Alliance for Quality Education (Agreement) in an amount not to exceed \$14,500 for the project described in this resolution, under terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-311660.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$14,500 from Council District 6: Fund No. 200205, Cost Center 1414111217 GL 512059, to provide funds for the above-referenced Agreement, contingent upon

the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
