A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING AS-NEEDED CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH CH2M HILL, INC. NOT TO EXCEED FIVE (5) YEARS.

WHEREAS, the contract with CH2M Hill, Inc. for As-Needed Construction Management Services for Pure Water Conveyance Projects to support the Public Utilities Department (Department) for a maximum compensation amount of \$45,000,000, and a maximum contract term not to exceed five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, this contract will cover construction management services for the Pure Water Phase I – Conveyance projects. This is one (1) of two (2) as-needed construction management contracts being secured for the Pure Water program; the first one is for the treatment and facilities projects, which is being approved under a separate action; and

WHEREAS, this activity is not a project as defined in CEQA Guidelines section 15378 because it involves execution of a contract which, on its own accord, will not cause a significant environmental impact. As such, this activity is not subject to CEQA pursuant to Section 15060(c)(2); NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute an agreement with CH2M Hill, Inc. for As-Needed Construction Management Services for Pure Water Conveyance projects, for a minimum of \$1,000 and a total amount not to exceed \$45,000,000, with a contract duration of five (5) years; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$45,000,000 in total from the following two Water Funds: 700011

(Water Utility Operating), 700010 (Water Utility CIP); and the following two Sewer Funds: 700001 (Metro Sewer Utility), 700009 (Metro Sewer CIP), for the purpose of funding the As-Needed Construction Management Services agreement, contingent upon adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year, and contingent upon the City Comptroller furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
