A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF A USED OIL PAYMENT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO CALRECYCLE FOR THE USED OIL AND USED OIL FILTER COLLECTION AND RECYCLING PROGRAM AND TAKING RELATED ACTIONS IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15308.

WHEREAS, the City is eligible to apply for California Department of Resources

Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) Used Oil Payment (OPP) funding once per year pursuant
to Public Resources Code Sections 48690 and 48691, and this funding covers the City's costs for
OPP-related activities; and

WHEREAS, the City plans to submit an OPP application to CalRecycle to receive payments to support the City's used oil and used oil filter collection and recycling program for Fiscal Year 2017/2018 through and including Fiscal Year 2023/2024 (Project); and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and

adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15308, and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of the Project, and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment as the Project is an application to secure funds to support the City's used oil and used oil filter collection and recycling program, which will further the City's efforts protect the environment; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego determines that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15308 and that an exception to the exemption does not apply.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego has determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
